
# STANDARD INSTALLATION REQUIREMENTS: COMBUSTIBLE WALLS & FLOORING


The diagrams below illustrate the minimum clearances required for installation of Jarrahdale Radiant Wood Heaters next to combustible walls. When wall materials are combustible, such as timber, a half-round Safety Flue Guard with a minimum height of 1000mm is required.
